Eligibility and Enrollment

The Parents as Teachers program is open to pregnant women and families of small children in Washington County and the Arizona Strip. Priority will be given to families who meet at least two of the following criteria:

- First time parents
- Teen parents
- Low income
- Referred by DCFS
- Children with intellectual impairment or physical disability
- Domestic abuse
- Lack of high school diploma or GED
- Experiencing homelessness or in transitional housing
- Recently moved to the U.S. with limited English
